The troop has also purchased Class B Hoodie sweatshirts w/ embroidered Troop 130 logo for all the scouts. They are really sharp and we think the scouts will like them. They will be handed out at the camporee.

**WEAR:** warm clothes. Layer your clothing.

**PACK:** Raincoat on top. Winter jacket, wool hat, gloves, Sweatshirt, pair longpants, shorts, short sleeve shirts, class B uniform, long sleeve shirt, thermal underwear, 2 pairs underwear, socks (several pairs), **waterproof boots**, extra pair of sneakers, hand towel, wash cloth, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, scout book, pencil, quarter, sleeping bag, ground cloth, foam pad, flashlight, matches, pocket knife, **mess kit**, **untensils**, compass, watch, first aid kit, canteen and a spirit to have a great time.

**COOKING:** The troop will plan all meals ( Saturday Breakfast, Dinner and Sunday Breakfast). The scouts will cook meals as patrols. Scouts may want to bring a snack for Friday night.
